KEYS

Fully Accessible

Wide doorways, level access at point of entry, or access via permanent ramps, reliable wheelchair accessible lifts, good lighting, seating available.

Partially Accessible

Fewer than three steps with handrail, narrow doorways to parts or all the venue, temporary ramps or lifts that require help to use, low lighting in some areas

Limited Access

More than 3 steps up or down, or fewer than three steps but no handrail, tight turns, narrow doorways, unlevel ground/flooring, or low lighting
